

The Galician Institute for Economic Development (IGAPE)

The Galician Institute for Economic Development building is one of a group of three which along with the IGE building (Galician Institute of Statistics) and the SERGAS building (Galician Health Service) belong to the Institutional Campus of San Lázaro.

The IGAPE building is a four-storey rectangular-shaped

structure with rounded-off corners, where the structure stands out as a main element in the architectural proposal. It has been built with beams that constitute part of the façade and the interior space. These beams rest on concrete diaphragm walls and solid steel columns whose number increases in accordance with the increasing vertical load.
