
Zarzuela Junction Bridges

The Zarzuela Junction is located on the M-40 ring road, at its intersection with the El Pardo highway and the crossing over the Manzanares River. It allows the connection between M-40, M-30 and El Pardo Highway.

In a very small area there are 2,247.20 lineal meters of viaducts or 32,760.00 m2 of structures.

It is a noteworthy solution that has been solved with pre-stressed concrete decks. There were several factors to be considered: the increase in the span lengths in order to reduce the number of piers, the spans had to be compatible with modest heights so as to employ the smallest depths possible and the adjustment with the shape of the cross section so as to exaggerate the length of the cantilevers in order to dissimulate the established depth.
